

eGate Filter Instruction Manual (for Android)

Who is it for?

eGate is designed for Android phone and tablet users, especially for personal and family use. It works as a simple device management system, giving you control over important settings—like which apps can be installed, whether Wi-Fi tethering or hotspots are allowed, and how the browser is configured. You can also use eGate to enforce a network filter, helping ensure safe and consistent device use.

Pros:

- Helps prevent factory reset and multiple user accounts
- Can be set to enforce Weatec approved DNS filter
- One-time cost

Cons:

- May need to factory reset the device before installation.
- Requires Android Debug Bridge (ADB) commands for installation.
- Not centrally managed & limited support options

Note: After testing, eGate has been approved as an acceptable category-based content filter if configured to meet the requirements set forth in the Weaverland Conference Electronic Technology Usage Guidelines. Please remember that no filter can be guaranteed to filter out all objectionable content; therefore the Weatec Accountability Software must be installed on all devices in order to be in compliance with Weaverland Conference guidelines. By logging all web traffic, the Weatec Accountability Software fosters brotherhood accountability. Keep in mind that, even if objectionable content is missed by eGate, the content will still trigger a flag on the accountability server. Use the following configuration as a minimum; there is nothing preventing you from choosing stricter settings.

How to Install (Android only)

Along with your license key and order confirmation you will receive a link to the eGate Install document. To set up eGate, you'll need a computer with ADB installed and a USB cable to connect your Android device. You'll download the app, install it using a few ADB commands, and then activate it with the license key you receive after purchase. (Alternatively, you could try a third-party installer like: www.mdminstaller.com.)

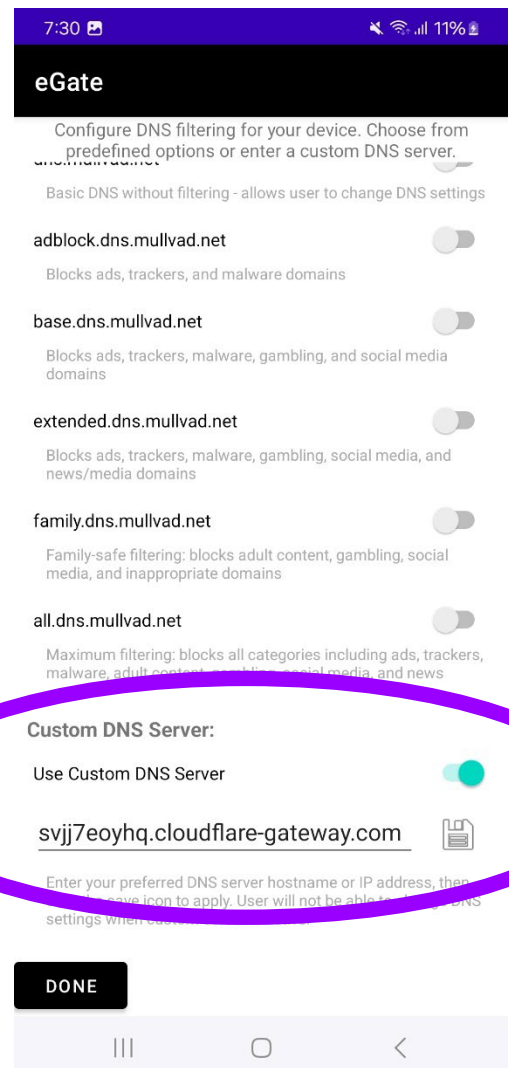
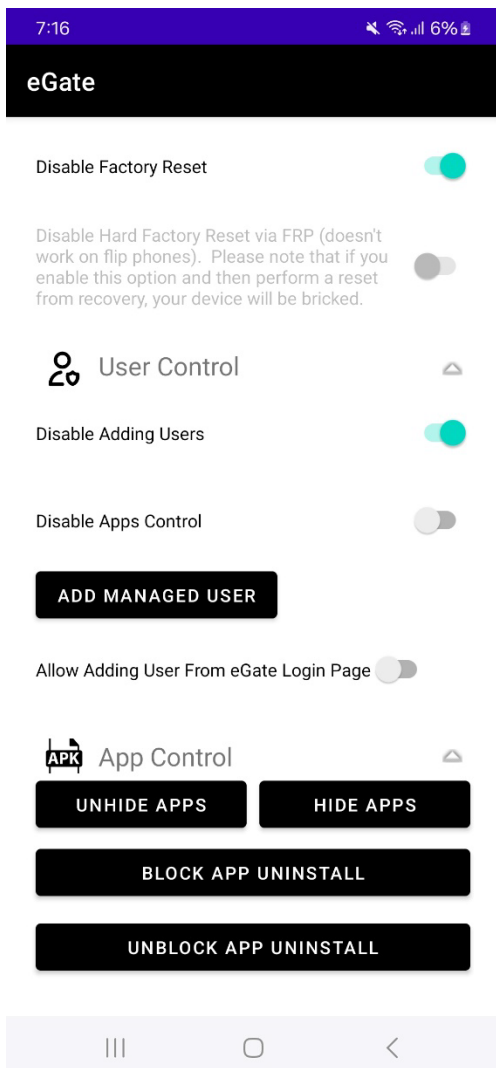
1. Once you have installed the app tap the eGate app icon on the device and enter your license code.
2. Set a password make it secure, as whoever has this password can make changes to the device settings and override the filter.

NOTE: This is a good time to open Play Store and install Ever Accountable.

How to Configure

Required configuration

1. Reset Controls: Disable Factory Reset: Yes
2. User Control: Disable Adding Users: Yes
3. App Controls> Hide Apps button: Checkmark/Hide: Chrome, Internet SBrowser, and any other bloatware apps and games that came with the device.
4. Set DNS Filter button: Custom DNS Server: Yes and enter svjj7eoyhq.cloudflare-gateway.com (This uses the same filter as the Weatec Flag Shield app. DNS filter maintained by Weatec.)
5. Enable Accessibility Filter: Yes



Extra precautions recommended configuration

1. Disable Hard Factory Reset: Yes; More control but read the notes before enabling.
2. Disable APK Install: Yes; Will block install of any apps Play Store or side load.
3. Block Webview controls in all apps: Yes; Will prevent loopholes in some apps but may require exceptions.
4. Disable Google Play: Yes; Will hide the Google app store.

And more. There are additional settings that can be used to further harden the device configuration.
